Sub: List of Villages not having telecom connectivity - regarding.

The Department of Telecom has initiated the process of development of database of villages that are not having any connectivity - landline or mobile. The process of development of database of connectivity status of villages of all States has been underway since July 2016. The database is yet to be uploaded online completely by your State. We are regularly in touch with IT Secretary in this regard. A word from you to the concerned will greatly help. The ultimate purpose of the exercise is to list all villages that are yet to be connected either by landline or mobile and provide mobile connectivity quickly. With the list of unconnected villages in place, it will be possible for us to develop a programme for providing mobile connectivity in those villages expeditiously.

I request you to please update the online database indicating the connectivity status of the populated (census) villages so that an action plan could be formulated quickly for providing connectivity to the uncovered villages.

I further request you to furnish the district-wise/block-wise list of villages in your State where there is no connectivity, latest by 15th April, 2017 to enable DoT to formulate a programme to provide mobile connectivity to all these unconnected villages.
