A w a r d:

These are proceedings for determination of compensation under section 11 of the Land Acquisition Act. The land measuring 17 bighas 02 biswas situated in village Amberhai was notified under section 4 read with section 17 and section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act vide notification No.F.15(93)/69-L&H(i), F.15(93)/69-L&H(iii) and F.15(93)/69-L&H(ii) respectively dated 19.2.1971 for a public purpose namely remodelling of Najafgarh Drain from Chhawla Bridge to Kakrola Regulator. In pursuance of the aforesaid notification, notices under sections 9 and 10 of the Land Acquisition Act were issued to all the persons interested in the land and claims filed by them are discussed hereafter under the heading 'compensation claims'.

True and correct area:

The land was measured at the spot and the available area found at the spot is 17 bighas 3 biswas. The area notified u/s 6 is 17 bighas 02 biswas. Thus there is an increase of 1 biswa which is due to measurement at the spot. The area now available for acquisition is 17 bighas 03 biswas.

Ownership:

The ownership, tenancy and classification of soil of land under acquisition according to the revenue records of the village is as under:

No compensation claimed.

Market Value:

The market value of the land under acquisition is the
value to the owner of the land in its actual condition at the
time of publication of notification u/s 4 of the Land
Acquisition Act and with all its advantages and with all its
potentialities. The best evidence available to arrive at the
correct market value of the land would be the evidence of
genuine sales effected about the time of notification either
in respect of land under acquisition or a portion thereof or
sales of land precisely parallel in all circumstances to the
land under acquisition.

As exemplars or sale deeds have not been filed by the claimants, efforts were, therefore, made at this end to find out parallel sale deeds so as to evaluate the market value. There are no sales transactions in the village since, 1966. Three awards, however, have been made in the village. They are 1990, 2017 and 2071 and the date of preliminary notification of them is 13.12.65, 27.5.67 and 19.8.66 respectively. In all of them, the Land Acquisition Collector awarded Rs.500/- per bigha kham. References u/s 18 of award No.1990 and 2017 are still pending decision in the court of A.D.J. Some reference of award No.2071 have been decided and the A.D.J. allowed Rs.540/- per bigha kham in LA case No.801/68 Dharam Singh Vs. Union of India. This is, therefore, the best evidence to evaluate the market value of the land under acquisition. Between the two preliminary notifications, there is an interval of about 5½ years. There is no other method except to pay 6% interest on Rs.540/- yearly for 5½ years to arrive at a ~~fair~~ fair and just market value of the land under acquisition. Thus, the market value of the land under acquisition is fixed at Rs.700/- per bigha and I award the same. t

Interest:

The possession of the land under acquisition has not yet been taken and handed over. The owners are not, therefore, entitled to interest at the rate of 6% from the date of possession to the date of tender of payment.

Solatium:

15% solatium will be paid for compulsory acquisition.

Wells, Trees and Structures

There are no wells, trees and structures on the land under acquisition.

Apportionment:

Compensation will be paid according to the latest entries in the revenue records.

Land Revenue Deduction:

The land under acquisition is assessed to land revenue at Rs. 6.80 paise. It will be deducted from the Khalsa Rent Roll of the village from the date of taking over possession of the land.

.P.15(93)/69-L&H(1):- Whereas it appears to the Lt. Governor, that land is likely to be required to be taken by Government at the public expense for a public purpose, namely, re-modelling of Najafgarh Drain from Chhawla Bridge to Kaula Regulator it is hereby notified that the land in the locality described below is likely to be acquired for the above purpose.

This notification is made under the provisions of section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, to all whom it may concern.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section, the Lt. Governor is pleased to authorise officers for the time being engaged in the undertaking with their servants and workmen to enter upon and survey the land in the locality and do all other acts required or permitted by that section.

The Lt. Governor being of the opinion that the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 17 of the said Act are applicable to this land, is further pleased under sub-section (4) of the said section, to direct that the provisions of section 5A shall not apply.
