In pursuance of notification No.F.15(156)/60-LSG (xxv) dated the 20th June, 1960 under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 issued by the Chief Commissioner, Delhi 31 bighas 14 biswas of land was notified for acquisition at the public expense for a public purpose namely for the Resectioning of the Najafgarh Drain Phase II, at Razapur Khurd. Because of the emergent nature of acquisition section 17(1) of the Act was applied and declaration No.F.15(156)/60-LSG(xxvi) of the even date was issued under section 6 of the Act by the same authority for the same purpose and area. An order was also issued for taking over possession of the land specified in the declaration under section 6 vide notification No.F.15(156)/60-LSG(xxvii) of the even date.

MEASUREMENT.

On actual measurement at the spot the area has been found to be correct. Its field wise details are given below

Satisfaction about the area has been made by the Acquisition Field Staff and it is, therefore, taken as correct.

COMPENSATION.

Inspite of the information to the persons interest for filing their claims about which notices were issued to them, they did not turn up and, therefore, the proceedings were made ex-parte. The Naib-tehsildar Land Acquisition vide his report dated the 25th November, 1960 proposed a rate of Rs. 300/- for Chahi and Sailab lands. He proposed no compensation for the land under the path which is already used as a public purpose.

DEPARTMENTAL REPRESENTATION.

The Executive Engineer, Construction Division No. III, C.P.W.D. New Delhi vide his letter No.C.III/A-1/6108, dated the 1st December, 1960 wrote to say that the rates proposed by the Na-ib Tehsildar appear<sup>ed</sup> to be reasonable.

FAIR AND REASONABLE VALUE.

I inspected the spot with Shri Tek Chand on the 27th September, 1960. The land under acquisition is a narrow

s-trip of land along the old Najafgarh Drain from the boundary of village Hastal towards the north <sup>of</sup> the boundary of Nawada Mazra Hastal towards the south. To west beyond the old Najafgarh Drain are situated the land of villages Ranhola, Tilangpur and Baprola. The awards of other villages have since been drawn up. The details are given below:-

*As per* sale transaction took place on the 11th February, 1960. Some of <sup>the</sup> area is situated near the abadi in a better position, while the land under acquisition is subject to the drain action in heavy rains. The persons interested belong to village Hastal who had themselves drew a distinction between the Chahi and Sailab lands. This estate is situated towards Najafgarh side and it would be very appropriate to apply the rates of Hastal because <sup>of</sup> its position and condition are almost the same.

The rates in the surrounding villages vary from Rs. 300 to Rs. <sup>350</sup>320/- of Chahi and from Rs. 240/- to Rs. <sup>260</sup>250/- of Sailab. Keeping in view the material on the file, I think Rs. 300/- per bigha for Chahi and Rs. 250/- per bigha for Sailab as fair and reasonable and award accordingly.

There is no well or tree in the land under acquisition.

CROP COMPENSATION.

Crops were standing at the time of taking over possession on the 11th July, 1960 for which the Naib-tehsildar has proposed Rs. 990.86 nP towards compensation. He has kept in view the yield of the last settlement and the rates given in the Delhi Gazette prevalent during the fortnight in which possession was taken. He has deducted 10% towards watching and nourishment of the crop as well as land revenue and cesses. I have no reason to differ from him and hereby award the amount of Rs. 990.86 nP. Details are given below:-

INTEREST.

Interest at the rate of 6% per annum will be added from 11th July, 1960 upto the 10th January, 1961, the anticipated date of payment to the persons interested.

AFFORTIONMENT.

Sarvshri Ram Chander son of Kalu, Gopal Singh s/o Tirkha, Ramji Lal s/o Paltu, Kanhi Ram s/o Chet Ram, Ganpat s/o Khubi, Bhoru s/o Net Ram are said to have died. Payment will be stopped till their heirs are brought on record. There are no details of the internal rights of Bhoru, Chhotu, Ghisa son of Kanapaya Ram and Lekh Ram son Bhola. Payment will be stopped unless this is got done through the Mahal staff. Payment will be made in case of others according to the recorded shares in the revenue papers as reproduced in the statement prepared under paragraph 55 of Standing Order No. 28.

NOTIFICATION

No.F.7(69)/70-L&B(i):- Whereas it appears to the Lt. Governor, Delhi, that land is likely to be required to be taken by Government at the public expense for a public purpose, namely for widening of Najafgarh Drain, it is hereby notified that the land in the locality described below is likely to be acquired for the above purpose.

This notification is made under the provisions of section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, to all whom it may concern.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section, the Lt. Governor is pleased to authorise the officers for the time being engaged in the undertaking with their servants and workmen to enter upon and survey any land in the locality and do all other acts required or permitted by that section.

The Lt. Governor being of the opinion that provisions of sub-section(i) of section 17 of the said Act are applicable to this land, direct that the provisions of section 5A shall not apply.
