Land measuring 2 Bighas 8 Biswas comprised in Khasra No.889/2, situated in village Tehar was not, if ied for acquisition under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act 1894 vide Notification No.F.15(III)/59-LSG dated the 13th November, 1959 issued for a public purpose namely for Planned Development of Delhi. Due publicity was given to the notification. Objections received under section 5(A) were duly considered by the Appropriate Government and on this a declaration under section 6 was issued under the authority of the Chief Commissioner, Delhi vide Notification No.F.15(127)52-59-LSG dated the 5th February, 1963. Notices under section 9 and 10 of the Land Acquisition Act 1894 were issued to the person, interested in the land under acquisition. The claim for compensation received in compliance with the notice is discussed in this award under a separate heading " COMPENSATION CLAIMS".

Shri Kishan Gopal claimant amongst other things stated that the land under acquisition is situated on Central Jail Road and is surrounded by various developed plots and colonies close to Subash Nagar, Hari Nagar Blocks, Fatch Nagar, Ajay Enclave in which amenities like electricity, water conservancy including sewerage etc. exhibt.

The claimant further requested that the sale deeds were filled in the court in Award No.1223 of village Tehar, and the fact that land is surrounded by 5 Pacca roads was also brought to the notice of L.A.C. while submitting claim in the above award. The claimant further referred to the following Awards the details are as below:-

LACK

The copy of the report made by Shri Murari Singh on 28.12.60 to
Deputy Commissioner, Delhi has been provided which is with regard
to the estimated cost of land intended to be acquired or purchased
by private negotiations by the D.T.U. In this report, the rate of
6.25nP. per sq.yard was proposed as the sought estimated cost of the
land. Another copy of the letter written by Shri Sampuren Singh
L.A.C. to Executive Engineer C.P.W.D. has been produced in which
it was pointed out that M.15 per sq.yard was reasonable price for the
purchase of land in Tehar I in which a tube well had been sunk,
Another copy of letter No.2(11)/60-H&T from Shri P.D.Garg Under
Secretary to the Covt. of India to M/S Sham Gopal Raj Gopal 7/4
Ajay Eclave Najaf Garh Hoad New Delhi-8 has been produced, in which
the Department of Rehabilitation did not have any objection to the
sale to the Firm of a piece of land measuring 2089 sq.yards at Ro.41.25 nP.

The demand of the land owner is exceedingly high. In award No. 920, sq.yd. the land for D.T.U. Shed was acquired at Rs. 5.00 per sq.yd. I do not know under what circumstances such a high rate was given for this land especially when the land in the neighbour-hood were acquired at Rs. 1000, Rs. 1500/- which related to Notifications dated 19.1.59, 191.1957 respectively. The land referred to award No. 1452 is situated near Abadi deh at a distance of about 1200 yards away from the land under acquisition and which is more superior and valuable, when compared to the land under acquisition. I have seen the land under acquisition, it is a very inferior quality of land, and is low lying and is away from the main road. The other copies produced by the claiment do not go to prove as what prices were paid ultimately in those cases and as such the same cannot be taken per se evidence for proving the rates mentioned therein. The lands referred in the claim are situated in better position and bear no resemblence with the under acquisition. The claimant has failed to produce any documentary evidence to substentiate his The claim in my opinion is high unjust, grossly, excessive and cannot claim. be accepted.

We have to find out the market value of the land under acquisition as prevailing on the date of notification under section 4, namely on 13.11.59. Quite a large number of sales were effected during the last 5 years preceding the date of the notification under section 4 beginning from year 1954-55. The average is as under:-

I have already made observations with regards to the rates given in awards No. 920 and 1452 under heading "(Compensation Claims)". As such both these awards cannot be taken into account while determining market value of the land under acquisition in this case is as The Award No. 938 is also not relevant as this award was covered by notification dated 19.1.59 issued u/s 4 of the Land Acquisition Act vide Award No. 988 against notification under ection 4 land was acquired for New Central Jail at the rate of Rs. 1000/- per bigha. The land acquired for the above Jail is not far away from the land under acquisition. Award No. 1163 was given against notification dated 19.1.57 at %. 1500/- per bigha, and this award is also not relevant. In the present case, I have to take the price as the same stood on 13.11.59. The average sale pricefor the year 1953-59 comes to is. 1356.60nP while the average per bigha of the land comes to Rs. 1255.10nP on the basis of the sales of the last 5 years. The most relevant award is No. 1223 which was given on

29.11.61 against the notification dated 13.11.59 for the Planned Development of Delhi. This award was given in respect of Khasra Mos. 886, 887, 888, 889/1, 890 to 896. Khasra Mo.886, 890 and 889/1 surround the Khasra Mo.889/2 on 3 sides. The L.A.C. assessed the market value in Award No.1223 in the following words.

"Taking into consideration the trend of prices, marking out of the plots and roads by the owner, the quality of the land (low lying) the average sale price for the year 1958-59, Award No.1169, and 988 in the neighbourhood and all other factors, I am of opinion that a flat rate of Rs.2500/- per bigha would be fair and reasonable market price in this case". The land under acquisition can be treated to be the piece and parcel of the land acquired by means of Award No.1223. I therefore considering all the relevant factors am of view that Rs.2500/- per Righa is the fair and correct market value for the land under acquisition on the date of notification under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act and award accordingly.

4. TREES? WALLS & UTHER STRUCTURES:

Since there is no tree or well or any other structure on the land under acquisition therefore, the question of determining any compensation under this land does not arise.

5. APPORTIONNENT:

Payment will be made on the basis of entries in the Revenue Record as existing in statement 'B' which has been prepared from the latest Revenue Record.

The possession of land comprised in Khasra No. 889/2 was taken on 1.2.62 by the Delhi Transport Undertaking, as this fact has been admitted by Shri P.D. Mehta, Assistant General Manager (A) D.T.U. in his letter No. A.D.M. I-50(42)/63 dated 23/4/63. So the interest shall be paid for the date of occupation of the land i.e. 1.2.62 up to 30.4.63.

Thence towards east along the northern boundary of Old Rohtak Road upto its junction with the eastern boundary of Shajada Bagh. Thence towards north along the boundary of Shajada Bagh upto the western Yamuna Canal. Thence towards east along the northern bank of western Yamuna Canal upto its along the northern bank of western Yamuna Canal upto its along the horthern bank of western Yamuna Canal upto its junction with the roads immediately west of the Andha Moghul Colony. Thence towards north along this road, immediately west of the Andha Moghul Colony upto its junction with Ambala Kalka of the Andha Moghul Celeny upto its junction with Ambala Kalka Railway line. Block K:

The traingular piece of area bounded by the Mall Road on the north; the Grand Trunk Road to Karnal on the southwest and Pambari Road on the east.

Block L:

Area bounded by the Pambari Road on the west; the Polo Road on the north; Vijay Nagar Road on north-east the Najafgarh drain on south-east and G.T. Karnal Road on south-west. (Except areas covered by:-

- (a) Gupta Colony,
- (b) Village Abadi Rajpur village, and
- (c) Area belonging D.T.U.)

Block M:

Area bounded on the west by princess street; north by the southern boundary of All India Radio Transmission Station; east by Kingsway Road and south by the northern and western boundary of Infections Diseases hospital and the T:B. Hospital.

Block N:

West by the Kingsway Road; north by the Military Parade Road to its junction with the Government land of Timarpur; east by the western boundary of Government land at south by the north boundary of D.T.U. Block Q:

Thence towards south-west along this katcha road and then along the south-eastern boundary of Krishana Namar, Gita Magar and the Government land of southern Chiragha up to its junction with the Shahdara Bund. Thence towards south-east along the Shahdara Bund up to the point of start.

Block X:

Bounded on north by the newly constructed Bund joining the G.T. Karnal Road north of Coronation Memorial, South-west by G.T. Karnal Road. South-east by the north-western boundary of Adarsh Nagar and east by the western boundary of Government land known as Pineri plans land known as Burari plane.
