PURPOSE OF ACQUISITION.....CONSTRUCTION OF ELECTRIC SUB-STATION.

In pursuance of notification No.F.15(iii)/59-LSG dated 13th November, 1959 published u/s 4 of the land acquisition Act, 1894 it was proposed to acquire 34070 acres of land in the various villages of the Union Territory of Delhi. Village Tehar was one of these villages. Subsequently an area of 4 biswas of land of Kh.No. 835 min situated in village Tehar was further notified u/s 6 of the land acquisition Act 1894. vide notification No.F.4(88)/64-LSH dated 19.4.65.

Notices u/s 9 and 10 were issued to the known interested persons requiring them to file claims. Claim ^{received} has been discussed at the proper place.

There is only one claimant who has demanded compensation @ Rs. 100/- per sq. yds.

The land under acquisition is 4 biswas. It is covered on three sides by colonies Mari Nagar, G.Block and on the east by Jail Road. Although there is vacant land in front, it is only about 25 feet from Jail Road. The land under the scheme is near about the land acquired through awards Nos. 694, 920, 1843. The date of notification of u/s 4 of the said awards is 31.12.51, 4-7-57 and 13.11.59 respectively. The award No. 1843 was announced on 6.9.65 and the land is about two furlong from the land under acquisition. The compensation offered for Block

'A' was Rs. 4500/- and Block 'B' Rs. 3000/- per bigha kham.

The claimant has not produced any document in support of the price claimed by him. Out of the mutation the relevant mutation is 3188 relating to 4 biswas which was sold for Rs. 875/- The price per bigha kham works out to Rs. 4375/-, the transaction took place on 31.5.57. Although many transactions have taken place since 31.5.57 the distance between the land under acquisition and the land sold is more than four furlongs. After the publication of notification u/s 4 one sale of mutation No 2885 took place. 5 bighas 18 bis were sold for Rs. 2500/- and price per bigha comes to Rs. 4237/-. The distance of these mutations from the land under acquisition is about half furlong and one furlong respectively. The situation of the land under scheme is better.

Under the circumstances after giving full consideration to the situation of the land, relevant transactions and demand of the claimant I am of the ~~max~~ opinion that a flat rate of Rs. 5000/- per bigha kham is just and fair market price and award the same.

COMPENSATION OF WELLS TREES AND STRUCTURES:

There are no wells, trees and structures ~~on~~ in the land under acquisition. Therefore, compensation has not been assessed.

APPORTIONMENT :

There is no dispute and compensation will be paid according to the latest entries in the revenue records.

INTEREST

No interest is admissible because possession of the land under acquisition has not been taken so far.

LAND REVENUE

The land revenue of the land under acquisition is reported to be 2 paisa. This amount will be deducted from the rent roll of the village with effect from the date of possession of the land has been taken over by the acquiring department. There is no temple mosque, grave yard or any other religious structures

on the land under acquisition. The land will vest entirely in the Government with effect from the date of its possession is taken over.




