PURPOSE OF ACQUISITION. PLANNED DEVELOPMENT OF DELHI.

In pursuance of Delhi Administration notification No.F.4 (92)/62-L&H dated 7.1.63 issued under the provisions of section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act 1894, 797 bighas 8 bis situated in village Tinar were notified for acquisition for the Planned Development of Delhi. Wide publicity was given. After receiving objections u/s 5A of the said act filed by interested persons, the Lieutenant Governor, Delhi was pleased to declare 80 bighas 17 bis of land u/s 6 under the provisions of the said Act vide notification No.F.1 (92)/62-L&H dated 1.10.66. Notices u/s 9 and 10 of the said act were issued to the interested persons to file their claims, which have been received and will be discussed at the appropriate place.

'MEASUREMENT'

The measurement of the area given in the notification u/s 6 was verified by the revenue field staff at the site. 2 bighas 8 bis were found in excess. This was left out at the time of adding up the total. Thus the total area under acquisition comes to 78 bighas 5 bis.

Out of 79 bighas 8 bis notified u/s 4 691 bighas 11 bis. have been acquired in Award No.1869, 83 bighas 5 bis are under acquisition in the present scheme and 22 bighas 13 bis are yet to be notified under section 6.

MARKET VALUE

Under the present scheme 83 bighas 5 bis fall under acquis
ition, notified u/s 4 through notification No.F.4(92)/62-L&H dt.
7.3.63. The area actually notified through the said notificatio
is 797 bighas 8 bis. Out of it 691 bigha 11 bis were notified
u/s 6 through notification No.F.4(92)/62-L&H dated 19.4.64 and
the same was acquired in award No.1869.

The L.A.C. breakup the land acquired in the said award into three blocks and awarded Rs. 3000/- for block A. Rs. 2000/- for Block B and Rs. 1200/- for Block C. Had the land under acquisition in the present scheme been notified u/s 6 along with the land acquired in award No. 1869. Kh.Nos 1023, 1036/2, 1037, 1038, 1039/1, 1047, 1048, 1049, 1050, 1051, 1052, 1053, 1054, 1055, and 1059 would have been placed in Block B and Kh.No. 1063, 1066, 1067 and 1068 in Block C. ✓

Aggrieved against the rate allowed in the said award, persons interested submitted reference u/s 18 of the L.A. Act 1894.

The A.D.J. Delhi in his judgements in case Nos. 561/1966, 603/1966, 530/1966, 563/1966, 604/1966, 560/1966, 578/1966 and 559/1966 amalgamated block B and C into one Block namely Block B and allowed Block A to continue as such. He allowed Rs. 600/- for Block A as against Rs. 3000/- and Rs. 4500/- for Block B as against Rs. 2000/- and Rs. 1200/-.

The rate claimed by the persons interested ranges between Rs. 10/- to Rs. 100/- per sq. yd. None has adduced evidence to sustain the rate demanded. Since the land constitutes a part of the land acquired in award No. 1869 and the date of notification u/s 4 is the same in both cases the market value determined by the A.D.J. in the aforesaid cases, in my view, is also the market value of the land under acquisition. I, therefore, award flat rate of Rs. 4500/- per bighakham.

STRUCTURES AND TREES:

There are no trees and structures on the land under acquisition. Hence no compensation has been assessed.

WELLS:

In Kh.No. 1053 there is a well. The well looks like a pit and it is not in serviceable condition. Hence no compensation has been assessed for it.

INTEREST

Possession of land has not been taken over as yet. Hence interest cannot be allowed. However according to the provision of the Land Acquisition (Amendment and Validation) Act 1967 simple interest @ 6% per annum will be allowed on the compensation awarded for

years from the date of notification u/s 4 of the L.A. Act 1894. Interest at @ 6% per annum on compensation awarded for land from 6.3.66 the date of announcement of the award will be allowed.

SOLATIUM

15% solatium is allowed as per L.A. Act 1894.

APPORTIONMENT

- 1) Compensation will be paid according to the latest entry of the revenue records.
- 2) Kh.No. 1047 in the ownership of Central Government has been auctioned in favour of Gain Singh, but it has not been mutated in his name as yet. Hence compensation will remain disputed.
- 3) The Managing Officer (Rural) Ministry of Labour Employment and Rehabilitation requested through letter No.3551(L)/Auc/S.O.(R)/480 dated 27.2.67 to withheld compensation of Kh.No.1066 to 1068. Latter through letter No.3549-51(L)/Auc-S.O.(R)/3554 dated 8.12.67 The said officer informed that his office had no objection to the disbursement of compensation of the said Kh.Nos to Balwant Singh. The said Kh.Nos have not been mutated in his name as yet. One Smt. Jai Lakshmi has claimed compensation for the said Kh.Nos by virtue of having purchased the said Kh.Nos from Balwant Singh. Hence compensation will remain disputed.

LAND REVENUE

The land revenue is reported to be Rs. 8.26P. It will be deducted from the Khalsa Rent Roll from the date of possession is taken or The land will vest entirely in the Government.

Whereas it appears to the Chief Commissioner, Delhi that land is likely to be required to be taken by Government at the public expense for a public purpose, namely, for the planned development of Delhi, it is hereby notified that the land in the locality described below is likely to be required for the above purpose.

This notification is made under the provisions of section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, to all whom it may concern.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section, the Chief Commissioner is pleased to authorise the officers for the time being engaged in the undertaking with their servants and workmen to enter upon and survey any land in the locality and do all other acts required or permitted by that section.
