Name of the village: Nawada Majra Hastsal  
Nature of acquisition: Permanent  
Purpose of acquisition: 'Widening of Najafgarh Drain.'

INTRODUCTION

Land measuring 17 bighas 8 biswas situated in village Nawada Majra Hastsal was notified for acquisition u/s 4,17 & 6 of Land Acquisition Act simultaneously vide notification Nos. F.7(69)/70-L&B(i) dated 15.3.72 & F.7(69)/70-L&B(ii) dated 15.3.72 respectively, for a public purpose namely 'Widening of Najafgarh Drain'. A corrigendum to the aforesaid notification u/s 4 & 6 was issued vide notification No. F.7(69)/70-L&H dated 25.7.72. Notice u/s 9(1), 9(3) & 10 were issued to the known persons interested in this acquisition, most of whom have responded by filing their claims:-

TRUE & CORRECT AREA

The land was got measured on the spot by the field staff u/s 8 and true & correct area was found to be 36 bighas 12 biswas instead of 17 bighas 8 biswas notified u/s 4,17 & 6, details of which are given as under:-

MARKET VALUE

The market value of the land under acquisition is to be assessed with reference to the date of notification u/s 4 i.e. 15.3.72 , Sale transactions of land in that village and awards in respect of similar land on or about the date of notification u/s 4 are to be taken into consideration while determining the market value of the land under acquisition.

The evidence filed by the claimants has also to be looked into. The judgment in L.A. Case No. 220/67 Ho Ram Vs. U.O.I. ~~xx~~ against award No. 1959 with date of notification u/s 4 24.10.61, by which the rate of Rs. 2500/- per bigha awarded by the Land Acquisition Collector was enhanced to Rs. 6000/- per bigha by the A.D.J., Delhi, has no relevance for the reasons that the market value has been assessed for the year 1961 and also the land involved in this decision is much better situated, being nearer the abadi of village Hastsal and Najafgarh Road, than the land under acquisition. Sale deeds mentioned at Sr.No. 2 & 3 under the heading 'Evidence' are unattested and relate to small plots of land which generally fetch higher price and are situated on the Najafgarh Road. For all these reasons these sale deeds are excluded from consideration. Sale transaction mentioned at Sr.No. 4 under the heading 'Evidence' also relates to a small plot measuring 415 sq.yds which is situated in the abadi of extension Nawada within the extending Lal Dora Nawada as mentioned in the sale deed itself and is much better situated

than the land under acquisition. It cannot, therefore, reflect the market value of land under present acquisition.

The following transactions which took place between December, 1970 and July, 1971 are reported to have been mutated in the revenue record:-

The land involved in these sale transactions is situated far away from the land under acquisition and is mostly recorded as Gadda. This explains the lower rate at which land was sold away. They cannot reflect the market value of land under present acquisition.

The following awards have been made:-

Award No. 1100 is not relevant as the date of notification u/s 4 in this award is about 12 years prior to the material date in the present case. Award No. 1923 is relevant for consideration because part of the Kh.No. 126, 127 & 140 acquired in this award is also being acquired now. The Land Acquisition Collector awarded a flat rate of Rs. 1000/- per bigha in this award and the A.D.J., Delhi enhanced the awarded rate to Rs. 1500/- per bigha in L.A. Case No. 101 of 1967 Richha Ram & others Vs. U.O.I. It appears from the case file that no appeal has been filed against this decision.

The market value of land was therefore fixed @ Rs. 1500/- per bigha on 17.12.65. Since the present notification u/s 4 is dated 15.3.72 and is about 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  years later, and the price of land has also increased during this period, I consider it reasonable to allow 5 % ~~xxx~~ increase in price of land during this period over the rate of Rs. 1500/- per bigha. It works out to Rs. 1988/- per bigha. I, therefore, fix the market value of Chahi land measuring 9 bighas 14 biswas @ Rs. 2000/- per bigha and the rate of Rs. 1500/- per bigha for Rosli land measuring 26 bighas 18 biswas as Rosli land is inferior to Chahi land.

#### OTHER COMPENSATION

There is no well, tree or structure on the land under acquisition.

#### 15% SOLATIUM

A sum of 15 % solatium will be paid on account of compulsory nature of acquisition as provided u/s 23(2) of the Land Acquisition Act.

#### INTEREST

As possession over the land under acquisition has not yet been taken the question of interest does not therefore arise.

#### APPORTIONMENT

The compensation will be paid according to the latest entries in the revenue record. In case of dispute which is not settled between the interested persons within a reasonable time the amount of compensation will be sent to the Court of A.D.J., Delhi for adjudication. *re*

NOTIFICATION

March 15<sup>th</sup>, 1972.

No.F.7(69)/70-1&B(i):- Whereas it appears to the Lt. Governor, Delhi, that land is likely to be required to be taken by Government at the public expense for a public purpose, namely for widening of Majafgarh Drain, it is hereby notified that the land in the locality described below is likely to be acquired for the above purpose.

This notification is made under the provisions of section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, to all whom it may concern.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section, the Lt. Governor is pleased to authorise the officers for the time being engaged in the undertaking with their servants and workmen to enter upon and survey any land in the locality and do all other acts required or permitted by that section.

The Lt. Governor being of the opinion that provisions of sub-section(i) of section 17 of the said Act are applicable to this land, direct that the provisions of section 5A shall not apply.
