Nature of Acquisition:

This is a case for the acquisition of land in the estate of Badli required by the Government at the public expense, for a public purpose, namely, for the establishment of powers for the construction of line of 220 K.V. Station in Delhi. A declaration under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act was made vide Notification No.F.15(82)/56-h.s.G. dated 1.11.56. The substance of the notification was given due publicity in the village and objections were invited. No objections were received. A declaration under section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act was made vide notification of even number dated 2.11.62. A notice under section 9(1) of the Land Acquisition Act was given due publicity while notices under section 9(3) and 10(1) of the Land Acquisition Act were served upon the interested parties. All the interested parties have responded to the notices.

LAND HELD BY OWNERS.

According to the notification under section 6 the total area to be acquired is only 7 biswas. The ownership of the land under acquisition is given below:-

CLAIMS & EVIDENCE.

The land owners have claimed compensation of Rs.10/- per square yard. They have given no evidence in support of their high claim.

MARKET VALUE.

The land under acquisition is situated at seven places and in each case about 1 Biswas of land has been acquired. The compensation is not ~~not~~ due to the price of 1 ml of one biswa as due to the damage, they will have to suffer. It is a continuous damage which is likely to occur on account of the passage of the electricity people through the land which will have generally ~~X~~ crops. The wires are likely to break down often and when they pass through the land, they will cause damage to the crops. I consider a rate of Rs.100/- per Tower as reasonable for the damage as well as the small cost of the land as well as any damage that is likely to happen.

APPROVAL NUMBER.

The compensation for Tower at Sl.No.3 and 6 will be paid in the ratio of 1 : 2 to the owner of less than a biswa and to the owner of a biswa respectively.
