Name of the village:

Bamnoli.

Nature of acquisition:

Permanent.

Introduction:

The land situated in the estate of village Bamnoli measuring 52 bighas and 13 biswas along with the land other villages is required by the Government at the public expense for a public purpose, namely for the widening of the Najafgrah Drain in the reach between Chhawla Bridge to Kakraula Regulator. A notification under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act was made vide the notification No.F.15(44)/66-L&H(i) dated 27.5.67. The provisions of section 5-A for hearing and inviting the objections from the interested persons were dispensed with and section 17 was applied for taking possession of the land under acquisition vide the notification No.F.15(44)/66-L&H(ii) dated 27.5.1967. Simultaneously a declaration under section 6 of the L.A.Act was made vide the notification No.F.15(44)/66-L&H(ii) dated 27.5.1967. A notice under section 9(1) and was given due publicity and notices under section 9(3) and 10(1) of the Land Acquisition Act were served upon the interested persons. Almost all the interested persons have responded to the notices given to them.

'MEASUREMENT & OWNERSHIP'

6 of the L.A.

According to the notification under section 4 of the L.A.Act the total area to be acquired is 52 bighas and 13 biswas. From further verification made on the spot under section 8 of the L.A.Act the area under acquisition was found to be 52 bighas 17 biswas. The difference of 4 biswas was due to actual measurement at the site. I, therefore, hold the area under acquisition to be true at 52 bighas 17 biswas, the details of which according to the revenue record is as given below:-

No evidence has been produced by the any of the above claimants in support of their claim for compensation. Hence the rates of compensation demanded by them are not sustainable. They are entitled for compensation as discussed under the head 'Market Value'.

'MARKET VALUE'

The land under acquisition which is in the form of a strip, adjoins parallel to the Najafgrah Drain, stretching from the Chhawala Bridge on the Bijwason to Najafgrah Road towards the boundaries of the villages Bannoli, ~~Dhul~~ Siras and Chhawala. The abadi of the village Bannoli is situated at a distance of about four furlongs ^{the east} towards of the land under acquisition. It is a low lying area.

Only two sales transactions of village Bannoli are forthcoming according to the revenue record. The one, covers under the mutation No.420, according to which the land measuring 14 bighas and one biswas was sold for a consideration of Rs.7730/-, thus yielding an average of Rs.550.20ps. per bigha. This mutation does not reveal the date of the sanction of the mutation or the date of the registration of the sale, with the result, that it is not clear as to to which particular year the above average relates. The second sale relates to the mutation No.428 according to which the area sold is shown as 22 bighas 18 biswas, but the sale consideration has not been recorded, with the result that the average rate cannot be worked out. Thus, both the above sales transactions cannot be relied upon for arriving at the market value of the land under acquisition as the relevant details are not complete. - on

Vide the award No.1126 the land bearing khasra No.551/1 measuring 16 biswas only was acquired for the housing site for Harijans in which the compensation at the rate of Rs.562/- per bigha was allowed by the Land Acquisition Collector. No reference under section 18 of the L.A.Act has however been filed, against the said award. The land acquired under the said award is just adjacent to the abadi of village Bannoli, whereas the land under acquisition is situated at a distance of

about four furlongs from the abadi as stated above. But the date of the notification under section 4 of the Land Acquisition of the award No. 11²~~16~~ is 22.2.1960, whereas the date of the notification under section 4 of the present award ~~is~~ 27.5.1967. Thus considering these factors I allow the rate of Rs.600/- per bigha for the land under acquisition excepting the khasra No.128(5-08) and 129/1 (1-18), total measuring 7 bighas and 6 biswas which are better situated as they abut on the Bijwasan Najafgrah Road and are very close to the Chhawala Bridge, for which I consider the rate of Rs.700/- per bigha to be a fair and reasonable market value and I award accordingly.

'OTHER COMPENSATIONS'

There is neither any structure nor any tree or well on the land under acquisition, therefore, the question of assessment of compensation does not arise.

Interest: In addition to the value of the land the owners are entitled for interest at 6% p.a. As stated above due to the application of section 17 the possession of the land under acquisition has been actually handed over to the Flood Control & Drainage Department, Division No.1 on 3.7.1967. Hence the interest is calculated w.e.f. 3.7.1967 to 20.9.1967, as the award is likely to be announced on 21.9.1967.

Compensation for crops: On behalf of S/Shri Rai Singh, Arjan Singh, Surjan Singh and Karan Singh ss/o Ch. Hargobind Singh, the compensation for the crops was demanded. But it appears from the report of the Naib Tehsildar(LA) dated 3.7.1967 that while handing over possession of the land under acquisition, no crops were standing on the land of the claimants. As such the question of loss of crops and assessment of compensation thereof does not arise. However, there was the sugar cane crop standing on the khasra No.14/1, measuring 1 biswas belonging to Shri Chandagi s/o Datta Ram, for which the Naib Tehsildar (LA) has assessed the compensation of Rs.20/- to which I agree and award accordingly.6

15% solatium for compulsory nature of acquisition: As provided under section 23(2) of the Land Acquisition Act the owners will also be paid 15% solatium for compulsory nature of acquisition.

'APPORTIONMENT'

The compensation will be paid according to the latest entries in the Revenue Record in presence of the interested parties, and in case of dispute it will be sent to the Additional District Judge, Delhi for disbursement.
