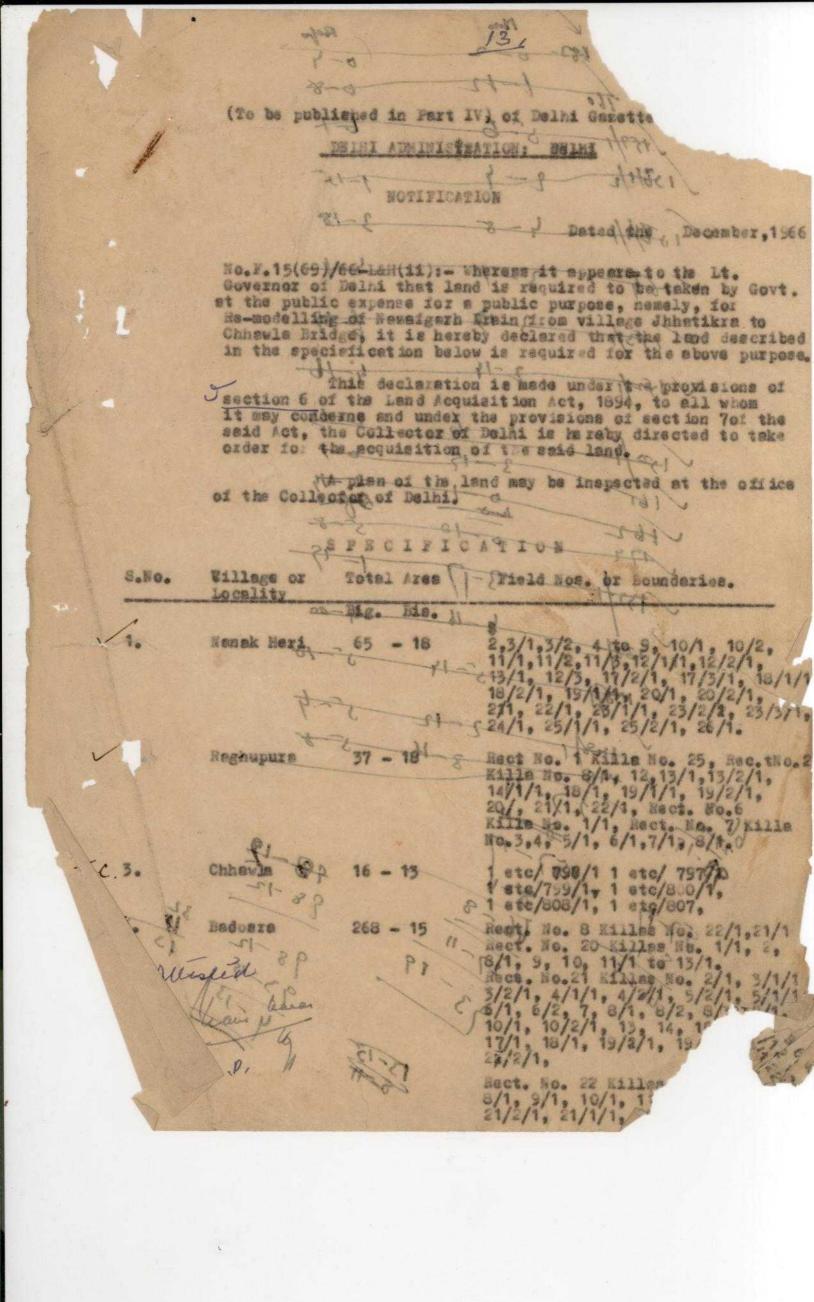

### A W A R D

Notices U/s 9 & 10 of the Land Acquisition Act were issued to the persons interested and claims filed by them are discussed hereafter under the heading "COMPENSATION CLAIMS".

# DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE:

None of the claimants have produced any documentary evidence.

## MARKET VALUE:

The market value tobe ascertained is the value to the owner of theland in its actual condition at the date of publicati -ion of notification U/s 4 of the Land Acquisition Act with all its advantages and with all its potentialties. By market value is reckoned the price which a willing vendor might reasonably expect to obtain from the a willing purchaser for the land in that particular position and with these particular potentialti -es. The best evidence available to prove what a willing purchaser would pay for the land under acquisition would be evidnece of genuine sales affected about the time of notification In determining the market value of theland the question of similarity between the two lands is of particular importance or in all other words land must be actually parallel. claimants in this case put forth exorbitant and almost imaginary claims regarding the market value of the land without any substantial corroborative evidence. Some of the claimants viz, Ghisu, Shanker etc. have filed a sale deed in which land measuring 9 bighas 12 biwas in village Bamnoli was sold on a consideration at Rs.18000/- on 22.12.66. A perusal of copy of the sale dded reveals that only Rs. 15000/- was paid before the sub-Registrar as the vendor admitted a prior receipt of Rs.3000/- from the vendee. The sale price includes the value of a well which was also transferred to the vendee. But this sale deed can hardly serve any purpose for the reason that the land referred in this sale deed is advantageously situated being just near the pottery factory and that its class of land is barani whereas, the land under acquisition is Sailabi. Moreover, the land is more than 11- 12 mile away from the land under acquisition. In view of these considerations, the sale deed referred to by the claimants cannot be taken as guide in evaluating the market value of the land.

Efforts were therefore, made at this end to find out the parallel sale deeds in the village nearest to the material date so as to evaluate the market value of the land. There has been two sale transactions in this village nearest to the material date which are described as below:-

Mutation at S.No.l as referred to above was not sanctioned whereas in mutation No. 420, the date of transaction is not known, with the result that it cannot be quoted as suitable examplar with reference to the material date at which the market value is to be evaluated. Thus both the sale transactions cannot be relied upon in arriving the correct market value of the land. In award No.1126, the material date of which was 22.2.60, the LandAcquisition Collector evaluated the price of land at the rate of &.562/-per bigha kham. The land lay almost adjacent to the village abadi of Bamnoli. No reference petitions U/s 18 of the Land Acc isition Act were filed against the rate awarded by the Land Acquisition Collector. Accepted awards of the Land Acquisition Collector are also very good evidence when the acceptance is for the property in the immediate vicinity, and a comparison can be made on merits. The land under acquisition is about 4 or 5 furlong away from the land acquired under award No. 1126 and its material date is 31st Decmeber, 1966, whereas the material date in award No.1126 is 22.2.60. Taking these factors into consideration I deem it fair and equitable to assess the land at the rate of R. 600/-per bigha kham. Kh. No. 131 & 132/1 total area 7 bighas 2 biswas are advantageously situated as they abut on the Delhi Nejafgarh Road and as such a rate of Rs. 700/per bigha is deemed to be fair and correct assessment of the market value. The same rates were awarded in award No. 2035, the material date of which was 27.5.67.

Kh.No.183/1(0-2) and Kh.No.155/1(0-4) are recorded as public paths as they are dedicated to public use; lener no compensation for the same is payable.

#### 15% FOR SOLATIUM:

15% solatium is payable over and above the market value of the land.

INTEREST U/s 17: The department has already taken possession of the land under acquisition and for its remodelling, the drain has already been dug. Consequently, interest is payable from 5.1.67, the date of taking over possession till 30.6.68.

APPORTIONMENT: Payment of compensation will be made to the persons interested on the basis of the latest entries in the revenue record.

## LAND REVENUE DEDUCTION:

The land under acquisition is assessed at R.16.56P as land revenue which will be deducted from the Khalsa Rent Roll of the village from the date of taking over possession of the land.

The aforesaid land will vest absolutely in the govern-ment free from all encumbrances.
