A w a r d.

These are proceedings for determination of compensation u/s 11 of the Land Acquisition Act. The land measuring 3 bighas 15 biswas ~~of~~ situated in the revenue estate of village Bamnauli was notified u/s 4 read with section 17 and section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act vide notification No.F.15(93)/69-L&H(1), F.15(93)/69-L&H(iii) & F.15(93)/69-L&H(ii) respectively dated 19th February, 1971 for a public purpose namely for remodelling of Najafigarh Drain ~~xxx~~ from Chhawla Bridge to Kakroula Regulator. In pursuance of the aforesaid notification notices u/s 9 & 10 of the Land Acquisition Act were issued to all the persons interested in the land and claims filed by them are discussed hereafter under the heading 'compensation claims'.

MEASUREMENT:

Through notification under section 6, 3 bighas 15 biswas have been notified for acquisition. The area available at the spot is 3 bighas 09 biswas. The decrease is due to acquisition of 6 biswas out of khasra No.15 in award No.2035. Thus the area available for acquisition is 3 bigha 09 biswas.

OWNERSHIP:

The ownership, tenancy and classification of soil of the land under acquisition according to the revenue records of the village is as under:

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MARKET VALUE:

The market value of the land under acquisition has to be fixed with reference to the price prevailing as at the date of notification u/s 4 of the Land Acquisition Act with all its advantages and with all its potentialities. The claimants have not adduced any corroborative evidence in support of their claims.

Efforts were made at this end to find out the parallel sale deeds in the village nearest to the material date so as to evaluate the market value of the land. The following statement shows the sale transactions made during the year 1970:

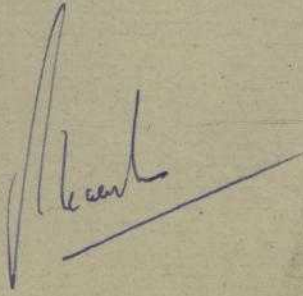

The sale at serial No.1 relates to residential plot. Hence it is discarded.

At serial No.2 is the sale transaction of agricultural land. 5 bighas 5 biswas were sold for a consideration of Rs.6000/- on 13.3.70 and the average per bigha comes to Rs.1162/-. The date of preliminary notification u/s 4 is 19.2.71. This sale can be used for fixation of market value of the land under acquisition.

A glance at the list of awards made in the village will not be an exercise in futility. One award No.2035 has been made in the village. The date of notification u/s 4 is 27.5.67. Against the rate allowed by the Land Acquisition Collector, references u/s 18 have been filed by persons interested. One case is 636 of 68 Mehar Singh Vs. Union of India. The A.D.J.

held the market value of land in the first category to be Rs.1350/- per bigha kham instead of Rs.600/- and the second category to be Rs.1550/- instead of Rs.700/- because the latter abutted on Bijwasan Najafgarh Road and the former did not have the same advantage.

This is a judicial judgment relating to one portion of land acquired in award No.2035 and the other portion is being acquired for the present scheme. It is, therefore, the best evidence to evaluate the market value of the land under acquisition. Through the average per bigha of sale transaction at serial No.2 is Rs.1162/- and is relevant for determining the market value, it will have to be discarded because the A.D.J. fixed the market value of the portion of land acquired in award No.2035 at Rs.1350/- and Rs.1550/- respectively on 27.5.67. The situation and other conditions of the land under acquisition is the same as the land acquired in the said award (2035). khasra No.129/2/1 is on the Bijwasan Najafgarh Road and the remaining khasra numbers are away from it, As such, it is but necessary to divide the land under acquisition into two blocks. Block 'A' will comprise of land away from the said ~~land~~<sup>Road</sup> and khasra No.129/2/1 min. will comprise Block 'B'. In a number of cases, the ADJ and also the LACs have <sup>allowed</sup> awarded 6% interest per year on a predetermined market value. If in the case, Rs.1350/- and Rs.1550/- respectively is taken to be the market value on 27.5.67 the market value on 19.2.71 would come to Rs.1650/- and Rs.1900/-(which is the round figure). Hence I award for Block 'A' Rs.1650/- per bigha kham and for Block 'B' Rs.1900/- per bigha kham.

#### INTEREST

The possession of the land under acquisition has not yet been taken and handed over. The owners are not, therefore, entitled to claim interest on the compensation.

#### SOLATUM:

15% solatium will be paid for compulsory acquisition.

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APPORTIONMENT:

The compensation will be paid according to the latest entries in the revenue records.

LAND REVENUE DEDUCTION:

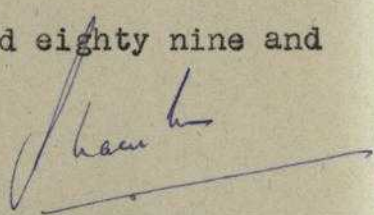
The land under acquisition is assessed to the land revenue amounting to Rs.0.90 paise. It will be deducted from the Khalsa Rent Roll of the village from the date of taking over possession of the land.

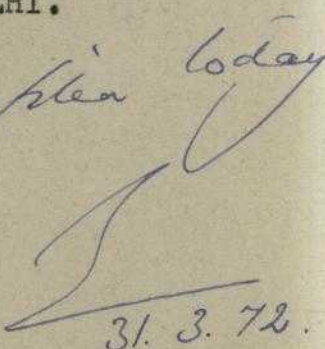

Governor Delhi that land is likely to be required to be taken by Govt. at the public expense for a public purpose, namely for remodelling of Najafgarh Drain from Chhawla Bridge to Kakrula Regulator it is hereby notified that the land in the locality described below is likely to be acquired for the above purpose.

This notification is made under the provisions of section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, to all whom it may concern.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the aforesaid section, the Lt. ~~Governor~~ Governor is pleased to authorise the officers for the time being engaged in the undertaking with their servants and workmen to enter upon the survey any land in the locality and do all other acts required or permitted by that section.

The Lt. Governor being of the opinion that provisions of sub-section (I) of section 17 of the said Act are application to this land, is further pleased under sub-section (4) of the said section, to direct that the provisions of section 5A shall not apply.
