#### INTRODUCTION:

The land situate in village Basaidarapur is need for temporary occupation and use for a public purpose namely for temporary dumping of earth. The Chief Commissioner, Delhi vide notification No.F.15(12)/64-LSG dated 6.3.1964 directed this Land Acquisition Collector to procure the occupation and use of the land for a period of one year from the commencement of such occupation and use under the provisions of section 35(1) of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.

Notice as required under section 35(2) of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 was issued to the interested persons. Almost all the interested persons have responded to the notices.

### 'MEASUREMENT AND OWNERSHIP'

According to the notification under section 35(1), the area under occupation and use is 8 bighas and 2 biswas comprising khasra Nos.219/2, 220 min, 221 min, and 222 min. But on verification at the site, it was found that khasra No.221 min is vested in government for road, and that on khasra No.222 min there is abadi and thus no question arises for dumping the earth on this area. Hence khasra Nos. 221 min and 222 min are excluded from the scheme and the compensation is fixed in respect of khasra Nos.219/2 and 220/2/1 only. The ownership of the land under occupation and use is as follows:-

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Shri Raghubir Singh s/o Mohan Lal has claimed compensation at Rs. 500/- per bigha as monthly rent for the land under occupation and use.

On my site inspection it was found that there is a park in khasra Nos.219/2 min and 220/2/1. The compensation is allowed in khasra No.219/2 only for plot No.25/measuring 4 biswas which was actually used for dumping the earth.

In the layout plan of Manohar Park the remaining area of 1 bigha and 17 biswas has been ear-marked for public purpose (Park). Hence no compensation is fixed for this area.

## CLAIMS AND EVIDENCE'

'Measurement and Ownership'. In evidence the owner has not produced any relevant document. The average rent for the land in this village as reported by the Naib Tehsildar(LA) is \$8.130.37 NP per bigha per year. Khasra No.219/1 which is quite adjacent to the land under occupation and use was acquired under award No.1230 in which the rate of \$8.3000/- per bigha was awarded. Considering the temporary nature of acquisition the average sale value of the land can be fixed at \$8.3000/- per bigha. However calculating at 4 % of the Market value (\$8.3000/- per bigha), the compensation comes to \$8.120/- per bigha for one year which is less than the average rent of the village. I, therefore, hold the calculated rent of \$8.130/- per bigha per year to be very reasonable and offer accordingly.

## 'APPORTIONMENT'

The compensation for 4 biswas will be paid only if the owner produces the sale deed or any other relevant document for plot No. in 25, Khasra No.219/2.

The date of publication of the notification under section 35( of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, namely 6.3.1964 will be treated as the date of commencement of the occupation. The P.W.D. therefore will return the possession of the land after the expiry of one year ie. 5.3.1965 in the same condition as it existed before, before taking it in possession.
