INTRODUCTION

Land measuring 2 bighas and 14 biswas comprised in khasra number 206/2/1 together with other land situated in village Basaidarapur was notified by the Delhi Administration for the purpose of planned development of Delhi. The Delhi Administration has issued notification bearing No. F.15(111)/59-LSG dt. 13.11.1959 in respect of 34070 acres. Due publicity to this Notification has already been given and objections already received had been disposed of. declaration under section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act was made Wide Notification No. F.4(35)/65-L&H(i) dt. 6.1.1969. Notices under section 9(1) and 10(1) were issued to the persons interested. In response to the notices only one claim has been received from Shri Matwal Chand resident of 4/25, Jain Dev Park, Rohtak Road, New Delhi. Out of the land notified for acquisition, the land measuring 2 bighas and 14 biswas is required by the Government for the construction of government school as per Land and Building Department, Delhi Administration's letter No. F.10(4)/ 73-18B dated 25.4.1973. Hence the present award.

MEASUREMENT AND OWNERSHIP.

According to the notification under section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act the total area of the land to be acquired is 550 bighas and 16 biswas. The Govt. is now requiring land measuring 2 bighas and 14 biswas out of Khasra No. 206/2 immediately for the construction of the Government School. As required by section 8 of the land Acquisition verification of the area to the extent ...2.

of 2 bighas and 14 biswas was found to be correct. Hence the present award in respect of 2 bighas and 14 biswas has been drawn up.

According to the revenue record the details of the area of khasra number 206/2/1 are as under :-

CLAIMS AND EVIDENCE.

Shri Mutwal Chand has filed claim in pursuance of the notices under-section 9 and 10 of the Land Acquisition Act. He demanded a sum of Rs. 100/- per square yard by stating that the land of khasra No. 206/2 is situated amidst the well developed colonies such as Punjabi Pagh, Bhagwan Dass Nagar, Jaidev Park, Ashok Park, Madan Park, Manohar Park, and other colonies in Punjab Garden. To substantiated his claim to the extent of Rs. 100/- per sq. yd. he filed a photo state copy of the decision of the court of Shri N.C. Kochhar, Addl. Distt. Jüdge and the decision of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in R.S.A. No. 182 of 1968. The decision of the Addl. District Judge is in L.A.C. No. 175 of 1971.

MARKET VALUE

The land under acquisition is situated quite adjacent to land comprised in khasra no. 2435/\$\formaller{1}\$ 236 and 238 acquired vide award No. 1629. The land Acquisition Collector assessed the market value of the above said two khasra numbers at Rs. 4000/- per bigha. The claimants had however took up the matter before the Addl, Distt. Judge under section 13 of the Land Acquisition Act for enhancement of the compensation. The learned Judge in case bearing No. L.A.C. 233/1969 assessed the market value of the land at Rs. 9000/- per bigha. This decision is delivered by the Hon'ble court of Shri G.R. Luthra, Addl. Distt. Judge, Delhi.

Therefore the claimant Shri Raj Kishore Andley son of late Mr. Shiv Narain Filed regular first appeal before the Hon'ble High court for further enhancement. The Govt. has also filed a cross appeal. Both these appeals were dismissed by his Lordship the Hon'ble Mr. Justice T.V.R. Tatachari and the Hon'bleMr. Justice Hardayal Hardy Judges. After the notification undersection 4 of the Land Acquisition Act there is no sale of the Land in the adjoining lands. However what-ever sale-deeds having been taken place during the preceeding year from the date of the notification under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act had already been considered by the then Land Acquisition Collector drawing the award in respect of land comprised in khasra numbers 238 and 2435/ 236. On the basis of such sale-deeds and other documents available, the thind Acquisition Collector determined the market value at Rs. 4000/- which value was increased by the learned judge as discussed above and assessed the market value of the above land comprised in the two khasra numbers at Rs. 9000/- being the rate of the land as on 13.11.59.

I have carefully gone through the judgement of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the decision of the learned judge assedsing the market value of the land in this village at Rs. 9000/-. I come to the concrete conclusion after keeping in view the kind of soil of the land under acquisition and that of its potentiallity that in the present case the best guide to determine the market value is the judgement/ decision of the learned Judge, Delhi. Accordingly the market value of the land is determined at Rs. 9000/-per bigha as has been assessed by the learned judge.

For the foregoing reasons, the claimant/ owner of the land is held to be entitled to the following amount of compensation:

- (a) Compensation @ Rs. 9000/- per bigha for land.
- (b) Interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum. under section 4(3) of the Land Acquisition (Amendment & Velidation)Act, 1967.

(c) 15 percent solatium on account of compulsory acquisition.

The rate of interest at Rs. 6/- percent has been determined due to the fact that the declaration undersection 6 was issued after the lapse of three years.

WELLS, TREES & STRUCTURES.

There are no wells, trees & structures in the land under-acquisition. Therefore, question of assessment of compensation does not arise.

<u>DEDUCTION OF LAND REVENUE.</u>

The land under acquisition is assessed to Rs. 2.09 per annum. The s-ame shall be deducted from the Khalsa Rent roll of the village from the next crop after taking over possession of the land.

A PORTIONMENT OF COMPENSATION.

The compensation of the land shall be disbursed to the rightful owners. In case there is any dispute of any kind, the matter shall be referred to the Addl. Distt. Judge for adjudication under section 30 and 31 of the land Acquisition Act.
