Land measuring 981 bighas 3 biswas and situated in village Basant Nagar was notified for acquisition under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 vide notification No.F.15(138)/61-LSG, dated the 24th May, 1961, issued under the authority of the Chief Commissioner, Delhi for a public purpose, namely for the Planned Development of Delhi. Due publicity was given to this notification as required by law and objections received under section 5A were duty considered. After it a declaration under section 6 of the said Act was issued vide notification No. F.15(138)/61-LSG/L&H, dated the 7th December, 1961, in respect of field No.13/1, measuring 52 bighas 1 biswa. The remaining land notified under section 4 was notified under section 6 under a different notification has already been acquired. Due publicity was given to this declaration and notices under sections 9 and 10 of the Land Acquisition Act I or 1894 were issued to all the persons interested in the land under acquisition inviting claims for compensation. Claims miled by the persons interested are separately discussed under the heading "COMPENSATION-CLAIMS".

TRUE AREA:

The Land was measured on the spot by the Land Acquisition Field staff in conjunction with a representative of the Requiring Department, On measurement the true and correct area was found to be 52 bighas 1 biswas as detailed below:-

COMPENSATION:

CLAIMS. The following persons filed written claims for compensation in compliance with notices under sections 9 and 10 of the Land Acquisition Act I of 1894.

- 1. Sarvshri Roop Chand, Harbans Lal, Garib Ram, Shanker, Chhotu, Chuni, Din Dayal alias Dina, Ghasitu, Kalu, Umrao Neta, Manphul, Hukam Chand, Amar Singh have filed a joint claim for compensation demanding Rs. 20,000/- per bigha kham as price for the land under acquisition. They also stated that compensation be paid according to the recorded shares as entered in the revenue record, but in proof did not lead any evidence. The claim is exorbitant and cannot be accepted in full as it is not based on any documentary evidence.
- Hardwari Lal s/o Parbnu Dayat, Hazari Lal s/o Chander 2. Bal, Madan Lal s/o Nand Ram, Sri Chand s/o Bhagwana, Sahai have filed a separate joint claim for compensation demanding Rs. 20,000/- to Rs. 25,000/- per bigha kham as price for the land under acquisition but did not produce any documentary evidence in support of their claim. Evidently the claim is exorbitant and accnot be accepted in full. They are only entitled to the market value as determined by me under the next iollowing pre paragraph. MARKET VALUE:

We have to find out the market value of the Land as prevailing on the date of notification under section 4, namely the 24th May, 1961. During the last 5 years preceding the date of notification under section 4, a large number of transactions took place which are listed in this Tile. The average of all these works out as under:-

There are some other transactions which took place in the immediate vicinity of the land under acquisition at the rate of Rs.3500/- per bigha for example-see Mutation Nos. 485, 486, 487, 488, 491, 505,506,537,554,567, 568 and 576. Some transactions even at lower rates took place but considering a very large number of transactions in similar Lands that took place in this village at the rate of Rs. 3500/- per bigha and taking into consideration a recent award for this very purpose in which the date of notification under section 4 was 17th May, 1961 and in which Rs. 3500/- per bigha was assessed as price of the land for similar land. I am of the firm view that the land under acquisition in this case should be assessed at the same rate i.e. Rs. 3500/- per bigha. I am assessing the compensation at the rate of Rs. 3500/per bigha keeping in view the fact that the Land has somewhat potential value as building sites and there are some Government colonies in the vicinity of the Land under acquisition and the Land has gained some importance due to the construction of Shanti Path Road which passes through the revenue estate of Basant Nagar.
