

AWARD NO. 29/74

These are proceedings for determination of compensation u/s 11 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894. The Delhi Administration issued notification D.P.R. 4(1)/37-L.A. dated 2.5.1967 u/s 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 for 2.5.1967 u/s 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 for acquiring 921 bighas & 8 acres of land in village Mirpur at the public expense for public purpose, namely, for the Planned Development of Delhi. The Delhi Administration has also issued the notification u/s 6 of the ... dated 2.5.1970 for determination D.P.R. 11(1)/70-L.A. dated 2.5.1970 in respect of the said land.

Notices in pursuance of above-mentioned declaration u/s 6 of the said Act were issued to the interested persons to submit their claims u/s 9 & 10 of the said Act but only one person has claimed in this behalf.

Measurement

The area under acquisition upto this award is only 9 bighas in the said Act, the remaining area will be acquired through a Supplementary award, since the area is found correct by the field staff on its measurement.

List of land

The details of land, as in Form 7-A have been recorded under para 55 of the Financial Comptroller's order No. 28 which are as under:-

The interested person has not raised any objection regarding the measurement and classification of land. At present there is no other alternative left when he seems to agree with the classification and measurement.

Market Value

Only one person Mr. Balbir Kumar a/c Shivalik has filed her claim. She ~~has~~ remained son of 125/- per acre. In addition to the payment of acquisition and interest, however. She has only stated that she had purchased his piece of land from Sub. Meenakshi Bai, w/o Shri K.L. Sharma on 28.7.61. She has not mentioned the rate at which she is alleged to have purchased this piece of land. On my inspection of the site I found that the Municipal authorities have already fixed the power transformer in one corner of this land after fixing four electric poles. Recently Shri D.S.L. Gaumet, Land Acquisition Collector has announced Award No.1/73-74 in respect of a piece of land measuring 141 sq.yds. in the same field. Actually I found that this piece of land which is being acquired is adjacent to the land which was been acquired by the Govt. vide Award No.1/73-74. Thus the market value of the land under acquisition should be more or less the same as has been awarded for another piece of land in the same place number this award No.1/73-74. Shri Gaumet, L.A.C. has awarded compensation of Rs.19/- per sq.yd. of the land measuring 141 sq.yds. I, however, find that the date of notification u/s-4 of the Land Acquisition Act in respect of Award No.1/73-74 is 22.7.63 but the date of notification u/s-4 of the L.A. Act in the present case is 5.3.67. After giving the benefit of lapse of one year, I hereby assess compensation of the land under acquisition as the rate of Rs.20/- per sq.yd. (Rs.20,000/- per Bigha).

Other compensation

There is no well, tree or structure in the land under acquisition. *P.L.D.P.* *Gand.../2.*

Platinum

15% of the market value of the Land will be paid in consideration of compulsory acquisition or exaction.

Enforcement

According to the Jamabandi for the year 1966-67 the land is shown in the name of National Housing Company Hazipur, Delhi while the claim has been filed by Mr. Lalita Kumar. I, therefore, direct that the matter is to be referred to D.J., Delhi w/s 3/31 of the Land Acquisition Act.

Land revenue deduction

Khalsa amount of deduction from the land revenue dues on account of land acquired will be Rs. 0.34 paise. This will be deduction of this amount from the khalsa roll of the village concerned.

The quantified land shall vest in the government absolutely free from all encumbrances w.e.f. the date of taking over possession.

Subject to the above remarks the award is summarised as hereunder:-
