PURPOSE OF ACQUISITION

: PLANNED DEVELOPMENT OF I

Introductory :

These are the proceedings for acquisition of land measuring 2 bigha 08 biswa in village Madipur. The land is covered under notification No. F15(245)/60-LSG dt. 10th Nov. 1960 made under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act and notification No. F.4(30)/63-I&H(i) dt. 9.1.69 made under sec 6 of the aforesaid Act.

Notices under section 9 & 10 of the aforesaid Act were issued to the interested persons and claims filed by them have been discussed under the heading 'Claims for compensation'.

True & Correct Area :

Area measuring 2 bigha 08 biswa of these proceedings was measured on the spot by the Land Acquisition field staff with reference to the revenue record. The details of the same with kind of soil are as under :-

Claims :

The following interested persons have filed their claims :-

Market Value :

Market value is to be assessed as on 10.11.60 on date of notification under section 4. All the relevant factors as provided in the Act, are to be considered for arriving at a fair & just market value.

The interested persons have not furnished any pr

in support of their claims nor any relevant sale transactions have been found recorded in the Revenue record. A few transactions are though recorded, all pertains to the sale of a small plots near the village Abadi, are not worth consideration from the situation point of view.

The only help which can be derived from arriving at the fair market value are the awards announced in the village close to the material date and judicial judgments arising out of these Awards. Relevant to these proceedings are the five awards detailed as under :-

Out of the said Awards some of the land acquired through Award No. 1691 is similar to the land of these proceedings. The present land is situated on the Main Rohtak Road & part of the land acquired through Award No. 1691 is quite close to it. In this Award land of Block A was assessed at Rs.2000/- per bigha on the material date i.e. 13.11.59. In a Reference under section 18, the Addl. Distt. Judge enhanced the market value from Rs.2,000/-P.B. to Rs.5,200/-P.B. in L.A. Case No. 139/69 - ' Ram Saran etc. Versus Union of India'. The Union of India has not preferred appeal against this judgment and hence this judgment is most reliable base of evidence to the market value of the land in question. No other judgment is available sofar. On the basis of the market value fixed in the said judgment, the land in question is assessed at Rs.5,200/-P.B. Kham & the same is awarded.

Compensation for structures :-

There is one Petrol Pump in khasra No. 583/2 of area measuring 1 bigha 02 biswa. This was set up prior to the date of notification U/s 4. But the persons in possession now has stated in his application/claim that owner of the Petrol Pump is Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd. This company has not filed any claim in spite of the service of the notice. Who so ever may be the claimant of the Petrol Pump, is allowed Rs.2,000/- for shifting charges for the material concerned.

Compensation for Trees :-

The following Trees are standing on the land presently under acquisition :-

Beri	-	One
Neem	-	One
Peepal	-	Three

The plants of the Beri & Neem are too small to be assessed. However Peepal trees have been found to be worth Rs.40/- in all. These trees stands on khasra No. 583/2.

Interest :-

Notification under section 4 of the Act was made on 10.11.60 followed by declaration under section 6 dt. 9.1.69. Interest under section 4(3) of the Land Acquisition (Amendment & Re-validation) Act., 1967 is attracted @ Rs.6% per annum w.e.f. 10.11.63 till the announcement of the Award.

Solatium :-

15% solatium will be paid to the persons interested over & above the value of land on account of compulsory nature of acquisition.

Deduction of Land Revenue :-

The land under acquisition is assessed to land revenue amounting to Rs.1.03 which will be deducted from the 'Khalsa' rent roll of the Village Madi Pur from the date of taking over possession of the land.

Apportionment :-

Compensation will be paid on the basis of the latest entries available in the revenue record. If there is a dispute which could not be settled here within the reasonable time the matter will be referred to the court of ADJ for adjudication.

Vesting of ownership :

From the date of taking over possession of the land the land will absolutely vest in Govt. free from all encumbrances.
