PURPOSE OF ACQUISITION: INCREASING THE CAPACITY OF NAJAFGARH DRAIN.

These are the proceedings for determination of compensation u/s will of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894. The land measuring 2 bighas 14 biswas situated in village Nilothi was notified u/s 4 vide No.F.7(73)/78_L&B(4) dated 30.5.79 and further adeclaration u/s 6 of the L.A.Act, 1894 was made vide No.F.7(73)/78_L&B dated 22.7.81 for the acquisition of land for the Increasing the capacity of Najafgarh Brain at the public expense for a public purpose.

Notices u/s 9 & 10 of the L.A.Act, 1894 were issued to the persons interested to file their claims in the land now under a equisition. Their claims are discussed under the heading 'Claims'.

TRUE & CORRECT AREA

MARKET VALUE

The market value of the land under a cquisition is to be determined after keeping in view the advantages and potentialities attached to the land. Todecide the compensation of the land, the record of this office was consulted and it was seen that Award No.30/82-83 has been announced in this village and the date of notification u/s 4 is the same in both the cases i.e. in award No.30/82-83 and in the instant case. Therefore, The market value assessed in this award was Rs.4000/- per bigha. I accordingly assess the same market value in the instant caseas Rs.4000/- per bigha.

OTHER COMPENSATION

There are wells & tubewells on the land now under acquisition. I assess Rs. 2500/- for wells and Rs. 1500/- for tubewells. The details of the same are as under:-

30% solatium will be payable to the persons interested on the market value of the land as compulsory nature of acquisition.

INTEREST

The possession of the land new under a equisition has not been taken over so far. Hence the persons interested are not entitled for any interest on this account.

ADDITIONA L COMPENSATION

As per provisions of Land Acquisition (Amendment) Act, 1984 the interested persons are entitled to get an additional amount of compensation calculated @ 12% p.a. on the markett value of the landfrom the date of notification u/s 4 i.e. 30.5.79 till the date of announcement of the award.

APPORTIONMENT

The payment of compensation willbe made according to the latest entries in the revenue record of the land now under acquisition. In case of any dispute the matter willbe referred to the court of Additional District Judge, Delhi u/s 30-31 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 for a djudication.

LAND REVENUE

The land under equisition is assessed to the land revenue at Rs. 4.66 and the same will be deducted from the Khalsa Roll of the village from the date of possession of the land.
