These are proceedings for determination of compensation under section 11 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894. The land measuring 30 Bighas 17 Biswas situated in village Ranholia was notified u/s 4,6 and 17 of the Land Acquisition Act, v/c Dalm Administration notification Nos. P.7(4)/77-L&B(i)(ii) and(iii) dated 21.2.1978 respectively for a public purpose namely Construction of Irrigation Minors.

Notices u/s 9 & 10 of the L.A. Act were issued to the persons interested and claims filed by them are discussed hereafter the heading 'Compensation Claims'.

TRUE AND CORRECT AREA :-

The land was measured on the spot by the Land acquisition field Staff and area found 23 Bighas 06 Biswas. On this area acquiring Department has built the pucca Nali. At the time of handing over possession to the acquiring Department, it revealed that Khasra No. 9/22min (0.04 Biswas), 13/2/1 min (15 Biswas) 13/2/2 min (03 Biswas), 13/3 min (02 Biswas), 13/10min (1 Bigha) 13/11 min (02 Biswas), 14/16/2min (05 Biswas), 20/22min (02 Biswas) and 70 min (09 Biswas) total area measuring 3 Bighas 02 Biswas is not coming in the alignment of the Scheme. These khasra Nos. may be de-notified from the above notification and Kh. Nos. 23/1/3/3 (03 Biswas), 23/10min (0-14 Biswas), 23/11min (14 Biswas), 23/20min (14 Biswas), 23/21 min (07 Biswas) and 23/25min (17 Biswas) total area measuring 3 Bighas 14 Biswas has been deleted from the notification i.e. 30 Bighas 17 Biswas. Khasra No. 14/5/1 min (13 Biswas) and 15/2min (2 Biswas) are not entered in the revenue records i.e. Khatamai etc.

Moreover Kh. No.9/21min (11 Biswas), 13/1min (11 Biswas) and 14/6min (12 Biswas) are to be notified as these Khasras are coming in the alignment of the scheme.

Compensation Claims.

- Has claimed that Shri Kanwal has expired and his minor son and widow i.e. Mrs. Patiyo is only entitled to receive the compensation of the land under acquisition.
- Have claimed compensation in equal share, as the Hoshiar Singh has stated to be expired.
- Have claimed compensation @ Rs. 15/- per sq. yds. for land
(ii) Rs. 10,000/- for the structure of the factory.
(iii) Rs. 10,000/- for loss of business.
(iv) Rs. 1,00,000/- for the other items.
(v) 25% solatium.
- Has claimed compensation @ Rs. 23/- per sq. yds. for the land under acquisition.
- Have claimed compensation @ Rs. 420/- per bigha for the land under acquisition.

DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE:-

None of the claimants has produced any documentary evidence in support of their claims of compensation.

MARKET VALUE:-

The market value of the land under acquisition has to be determined with reference to the price prevailing at the date of preliminary notification u/s 4 of the L.A. Act, with all advantages and with all its potentialities. The best evidence available to arrive at the correct market value of the land would be the evidence of general sales effected near about the time of notification either in respect of the land under acquisition or the portion thereof or the sale of land almost parallel in all circumstances to the land under acquisition.

Efforts were however made to find out the parallel sale facts in the village nearest to the material date so as to evaluate the market value of the land. The following statement shows the sale transaction executed near about the material date of notification u/s 4 of the L.A. Act, in village Roshala.

The above sale facts which have been executed in this village during the period of five year prior to the date of preliminary notification u/s 4 i.e. 21.2.74, relate to the small plots of land measuring 100-200 yards only, and these sale facts cannot be taken into consideration while assessing the true market value of the land under acquisition.

These sale goods are presumably for residential purposes. It may not be out of place to mention here that Pahla Land Reforms Act, is applicable to the land of village Ranholi.

In view of the restrictions of sections 23 and 24 of Pahla Land Reforms Act, the land in question could be used only for the purpose of agriculture, horticulture or animal husbandry etc. It is, therefore, not possible to consider such sale goods for assessing the true market value of the land under acquisition.

In village Ranholi some awards have been made.

In award No. 76/20-21, which is drawn recently on 27-10-80 the Land Acquisition Collector has given flat rate of Rs.125/- per bigha.

The date of preliminary notification u/s 4 of this award is 18.8.78 whereas the date of preliminary notification u/s 4 of the L.A. Act or the present award is 21.2.78.

There is a gap of about 6 months only between the preliminary notification u/s 4 of the L.A. Act, in award No. 76/20-21 and the present award. Since there is no material difference in the land under acquisition as that of the land acquired u/s 4 award No. 76/20-21. I determine the value of the abysk land at Rs.125/- per bigha and that of Banjar Qadim @ Rs.80/- per bigha.

TREES, WALL AND STRUCTURES:-

15% solation is admissible on the amount of compensation as per L.A. Act.

INTEREST:-

The possession of the land under acquisition has been taken over and handed over to the acquiring department on 15-7-78. The interest is payable to the persons interested as per L.A. Act to the date of announcement of the award.

PARTITION:-

The payment of compensation will be made according to the last entries in the revenue records.

REVENUE:-

The land under acquisition is given below:

revenue which will be deducted from the Khalsa Rent Roll of the village from the date of possession.
