On receiving of application from the applicant, the concerned Patwari will scrutinize the particulars of applicant and Khasra Nos from Naksha Muntajmin and then submit his report for further process to Kanungo. Concerned Kanungo will thoroughly check the file and submit his report and remarks to NT (LAC)/Tehsildar (LA). After checking by NT (LAC)/Tehsildar (LA), the file be sent to Account Clerk, who checks the amount from Statement A and also once again check the above mentioned documents as correct as per SOP. - 3. After getting the signature on cheque by LAC, the same will be disbursed to the applicant alongwith payment certificate. The following documents will be obtained from the applicant:
 - (a) A photocopy of PAN Card or Form 16 as the case may be.
 - (b) Revenue Stamp of Rs 1/- affixing on receipt and signature of claimant on it.
 - (c) An entry of cheque is made in Register and get it signed from the applicant.
 - (d) Identity proof of all concerned at the time of release of cheque.
 - (e) Obtain signature of applicant on concerned documents to verify the correctness.
- 4. The release of payment is subject to receiving of Payment from Land & Building Department/Requisitioning Department.
